Drug Related Arrests by Drug


The total number of persons of drug related arrests was 97,416 in 2020. Among them, there were 51,603 (53.0%) persons for heroin related arrests and 41,080 (42.2%) persons for cannabis related arrests. In addition, 2,387 (2.5%) persons for methamphetamine, 361 persons for psychotropic substances, 71 persons for hashish and 31 persons were arrested for cocaine.

Drug Related Arrests by District

By considering the total number of arrests, highest number of arrested persons, 22,619 (23.2%) were reported from Colombo district followed by (12,988) 13.3 % of arrested persons from Gampaha district, 7.5 % of arrested persons from Kurunegala district and 6.1 % of persons from Galle district. Lowest number of arrested persons, (0.1%) were reported from Mulativu district.


Graph No: 02 - Heroin and Cannabis Related Arrests by District

Highest number of heroin related arrested persons, 12,990 (25%) were reported from Colombo district followed by 9,029 (17%) persons from Gampaha district, 4,081 (8%) of arrested persons from Kurunegala district and 3,581 (7%) of persons from Galle district. In addition to heroin, there has been an emerging trend on methamphetamine related arrests in 2020 compared to the last year. The highest numbers of methamphetamine arrests were reported from the Colombo district (1,767) 74% followed by Gampaha (327) 14% and Kalutara (61).

Drug Related Arrests by Province

Majority of the drug related arrests, 41,170 (42 %), was reported from Western province followed by 11,558 (12%) of arrests from North Western and 10,162(10%) of arrests from Southern province. Lowest number of drug related arrests, 3380 (3%) was reported from Eastern Province.







Seized Quantities of Drugs (Kg)

By considering the seized quantities of drugs Island-wide, 1,630.156 kg of heroin and 16,195.415 kg of cannabis were seized in 2020. In addition, 1.630kg of cocaine, 0.671kg of hashish, 811.8kg of methamphetamine and 9.491 kg of psychotropic substances were seized. Also 36,082 of capsule (pharmaceutical drugs) and 44,064 of tablets (pharmaceutical drugs and other psychoactive substance) were seized during the year 2020.
