DRUG RELATED TREATMENT ADMISSIONS



Drug Abuse Monitoring System (DAMS) is a computerized information system, which collects information on persons arrested for drug related offences and persons seeking treatment for drug dependence. The total number of reported drug users who had received treatment services during the period of January to October of 2022 was 1376. Of the total reported drug users, 37.3% received treatment from the treatment and rehabilitation center of National Dangerous Drugs Control Board (NDDCB). 5% from prisons drug treatment rehabilitation programme, 19.5% from NGOs and 38.2% from Kandakadu Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre of Bureau of Commissioner General of Rehabilitation (BCGR).
